The examination fees charged by the College include administration costs associated with sitting the exams.</p> <p>Tuition deposit - this is offset against educational trips, extra curricular activities, examination fees, theatre visits etc.</p> <p>Damage deposit (day and boarding) - this is held by the College and returned at the end of the course. If a student causes any damage to school property the costs of repairs will be deducted from the damage deposit.</p> <p>Refundable deposits will be returned once the Bursar has closed the account at the end of September following the results period in the year the student leaves RIC.</p> <p>Boarding fees include all meals, cleaning, bed linen and laundry service.</p>
