Fees are payable in three termly or 10 monthly instalments

We do not charge supplements for any subjects except

English as a Foreign Language £900 per term

Fees are based on 3 or more A levels and 5 or more GCSEs

Individual tuition including SEN support can be arranged where required at £450 for 10 hours

Examination entry fees are chargeable and depend on the number of subjects a student takes in each session. The examination fees charged by the College include administration costs associated with sitting the exams.

Tuition deposit - this is offset against educational trips, extra curricular activities, examination fees, theatre visits etc.

Damage deposit (day and boarding) - this is held by the College and returned at the end of the course. If a student causes any damage to school property the costs of repairs will be deducted from the damage deposit.

Refundable deposits will be returned once the Bursar has closed the account at the end of September following the results period in the year the student leaves RIC.

Boarding fees include all meals, cleaning, bed linen and laundry service.
