

Top 15 Independent schools in Kent and Medway for value added progress at A level

This A level performance score measures the progress sixth form students make. DfE Performance Tables 2020.

This means on average that RIC students achieve 0.42 of a grade higher in their A levels than students elsewhere with the same GCSE grades, helping them secure places at their first choice universities.

RIC is not academically selective, either at 11+ or sixth form. Our students' average A level grade of B- is though comfortably above many selective schools, both independent and grammar, nationwide.
