If a student causes any damage to school property the costs of repairs will be deducted from the damage deposit.</p> <p><b>Refundable deposits</b> will be returned once the Bursar has closed the account at the end of September following the results period in the year the student leaves RIC.</p> <p><b>Boarding fees</b> include all meals, cleaning, bed linen and laundry service.</p>
